Our pilots are anxiously awaiting their training in our new planes. There is a family coming to PNG just to train our pilots and they will hopefully be here in the next few weeks. Only a few short years ago we were so short on pilots we were not sure how we were going to keep our aviation program running. Now we have 6 pilots here in PNG and more on the way – including Jon Leedhal – who lost his leg about a year ago and has now been cleared to fly again. God is so good!



This plane is truly a blessing to our tribal missionaries. Before, they would have to charter the flight to come to their location and pay for the full cost. Now, this plane can hold more cargo and fuel, so it can go to multiple locations in one trip!

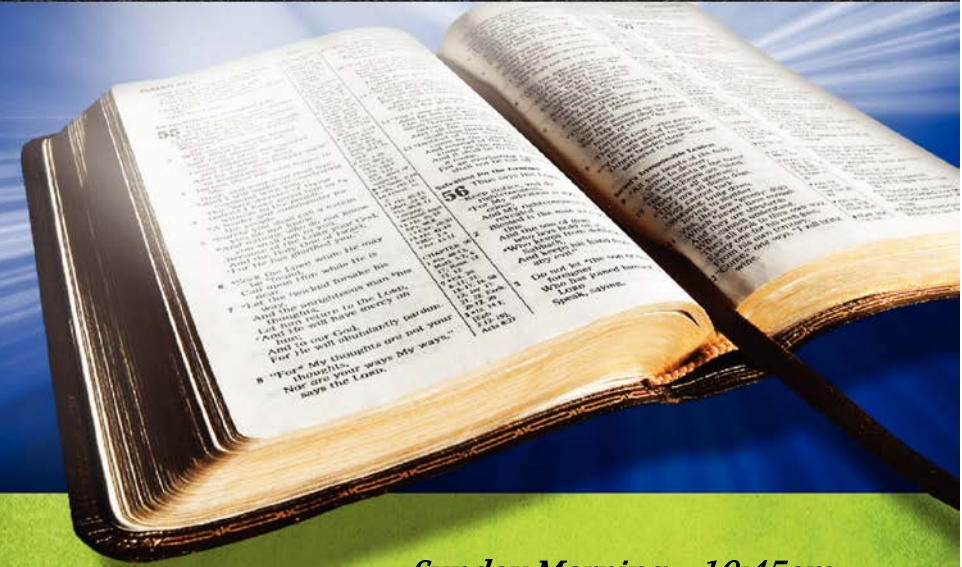
