Dave and Judy Wright have been tribal church planters amongst the Mungen People of Papua New Guinea. The Mungen people are animistic and number in excess of 12,000 speaking three dialects and were unreached in the truest sense of the word. God allowed the Wrights the privilege of being a part of the team that reduced their language to writing to teach and translate God's Word. Today there are two churches, two more church plants, and 80+ believers that are well on their way to maturity. Praise the Lord!

As a result, God has moved Dave and Judy on to a new ministry with Ethnos in Canada, namely, church development. They are adapting Ethnos's sharpened church planting/discipleship materials in partnership with the Canadian church, immigrant church, First Nations church and missions. Already, God has opened the door to begin partnering with two groups of First Nations Christian leaders in Saskatchewan and to unpack it at their sending church.

Ethnos (formerly, New Tribes Mission) began in 1942 and has become one of the largest mission organizations working in Bible translation and church planting worldwide. It remains committed to its focus to reach unreached people groups that have no access to the gospel.

God has been clearly leading our Missions Coaching Team to focus on those in our world who are most vulnerable to oppression and need, children and women.

We have narrowed the choices to four places: Columbia, Pakistan, Lebanon, and Honduras.

“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come” (2 Corinthians 5:17).

“For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit, in which he went and proclaimed[c] to the spirits in prison, because they formerly did not obey, when God's patience waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through water. Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers having been subjected to him” (1 Peter 3:18-22).
